

PARISH MARRIAGE RECORDS DONATED TO THE STATE ARCHIVES

Le Comité des Archives de la Louisiane, Inc., is pleased to announce a donation of 56 reels of microfilm of civil marriage records to the Louisiana State Archives. This collection consists of marriage indexes and records for four Louisiana parishes.

The microfilm was purchased from the Genealogical Society of Utah with the permission of the respective parish Clerks of Court. The collection has not been assigned an accession number, but is available in the Research Room in the microfilm area. They can be found in Microfilm Cabinet 701, Drawers 11 and 12.

Since 1996, Le Comité has donated over \$20,000 in microfilmed records to the State Archives. In addition to a number of parish Clerk of Court records, these have included censuses, colonial period records, city directories, naturalization records, military records, church records, and ship passenger lists.
